



PROLONGED TRAFFIC DELAYS ON A2 AND A67/E34 RANDWEG EINDHOVEN

WIDENING OF RANDWEG EINDHOVEN

The ring-road around Eindhoven, 'Randweg Eindhoven', is to be completely changed. Fly-overs are being altered and renewed and motorway junctions entirely renovated. The number of lanes will be increased from two to four. The aim is to separate through traffic and regional traffic.

Until the end of the work in mid-2010, users of the Randweg Eindhoven can expect diversions and delays.

The Directorate-General for Public Works and Water Management advises road users to avoid the Randweg Eindhoven during rush hour over the next few years. Outside rush hours, Eindhoven will remain accessible to local traffic.
